Rick's V-Rod parts: performance á la carte!

Rick's address is Flugstrasse 1, and this street name has the history of being the location where the old Baden-Baden airport used to be – not only one of the first airports in Germany and worldwide, but even Count Zeppelin landed here with his airships when the first air traffic corridor Friedrichshafen-Baden-Mannheim was operational. And Anthony Fokker, constructor of the most important German fighter planes of the 1st World War, is said to have tested some of his record braking prototypes here. Baden-Baden was then more than 100 km away from France. By 2010, the 100-year old air strip was only used by small airplanes and gliders. Nowadays only "Low Flyers" are causing a stir here: the hottest V-Rods from the neighbouring "House of Custom".
